Building block:

Country experiences with implementation

- central part of HLPF review under the auspices of ECOSOC, building on and replacing AMR-NVPs
- focus on national implementation efforts
 "how" do countries translate and implement SDGs?
- visible, transparent, and flexible
- highlighting success models, challenges and potentials for improvement
- take national strategies as point of reference
- take national circumstances and capacities into account
- incentives
- visibility and knowledge sharing
- motivate and inform effective planning, decision-making and investment
- match demand and supply of means of implementation: tailored support, platform for supportive partnerships
- option: prize for best implementation idea/effort under each goal?

• national voluntary presentations periodic (ideally 3 in 15 years)

- basis:
- national progress report
- summary of input by Major Groups and other stakeholders (like local authorities or SMEs and their concrete experiences with implementation)
- summary of UN entities' data and information
- harmonized format for presentations:
- cover all SDGs, for each goal one best practice example and one challenge where recommendations and further tailored support are appreciated
- -first round: focus on national commitments and framework for implementation, also assess demand and supply of means of implementation
- second and third round: focus on implementation experiences, follow-up of recommendations and effectiveness of measures and means of implementation
 - state-led interactive debate with concrete recommendations and ideas for tailored support
 - results inform HLPF political guidance and ministerial declaration
